Greetings from the University of King's College!

King's scholarships are designed to reward students' academic achievements and, in many cases, their community involvement. This letter and the attached posters provide information about King's scholarships available to high school students. We would greatly appreciate if you could share this information. Major Entrance Scholarships

The application deadline for Major Entrance Scholarships is January 15, 2018.

Donald R. Sobey Family Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic excellence, proven leadership skills, and involvement in school and/or community activities. The total award is **\$50,000**, with recipients receiving \$17,000 in their first year of study and \$11,000 in each of three subsequent years. Applicants must be Canadian citizens and be entering the first year of the Foundation Year Programme (FYP) at the University of King's College.

Dr. Carrie Best Scholarship

This award honours Dr. Carrie Best, the first African-Canadian publisher in Nova Scotia as well as an accomplished writer and human rights activist. Applicants of African-Canadian or Indigenous descent are eligible to apply for this award, which has a total value of **\$20,000**, with recipients receiving \$5,000 a year and renewable for up to four years.

Harrison McCain Award

High school graduates in Canada are eligible for a Harrison McCain Award, which have a total value of **\$16,000**, with recipients receiving \$4,000 a year and renewable for up to four years.

Colin Starnes Award

This award is granted on academic merit and demonstrated financial need. Each year, this award is given to a deserving and capable Nova Scotian student who, without financial assistance, may not otherwise be able to attend King's. Foundation Year Programme (FYP) applicants who graduate from high schools in Nova Scotia are eligible for the Colin Starnes Award, valued at **full tuition plus incidental fees** for the first year of study at King's. It is non-renewable, but the recipient is automatically considered for in-course scholarships after first year.

King's Theatrical Society Award

This award is for entering students who have demonstrated service and initiative within their local theatre community. Students with an average of 80% or above are eligible.

There will be one award of **\$2,000** and three awards of **\$1,000**, which may be awarded on their own or in combination with other entrance awards.

Choral and Organ Scholarships

Choral and organ scholarships for King's and Dal students are awarded each year based on merit, as demonstrated during the student's audition. These scholarships range from **\$400 to \$4,000** per academic year. Information on auditioning can be found online.

General Entrance Scholarships

Students who apply to King's by **March 1** are automatically considered for a general entrance scholarship, valued between **\$500** and **\$3500**:

- 80-84.9%: \$500
- 85-89.9%: \$2000
- 90-94.9%: \$2500
- 95%+: \$3500

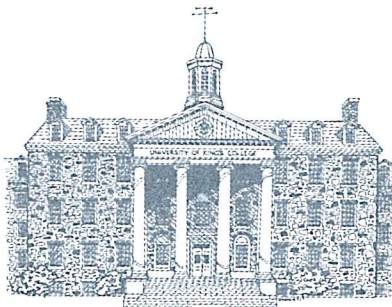
We also provide funding based on financial need.
